## 1.10 Jehovah Nissi

Bible Verse: I Corinthian 15:57

Thanks be to God! He gives us the victory

through our Lord Jesus Christ!

**Proclaim:** The Lord God is the one who has trampled all our enemies.

**Truth:** I will shout joyfully unto the Lord, for through His death on the cross, He has triumphed over the evil one. Now we can have

victory in all things through Christ Jesus.

(Isaiah 14:12-15; Rev 12:9)

Scripture Reference: Psalm 9:6-7

Lesson: (1) The fallen angels — The Bible records that before the creation of man, the Lord God had created the angels.

Among the angels was one named Lucifer. His intelligence and power surpassed the rest of the angels and God appointed him to be an archangel. God's word reveals that Lucifer became proudly. He sought equal status with God and revolted against God. When the Lord God's anger fell upon him, Lucifer was cast down to the earth, together with the portion of angels who had followed him, and they became fallen.

- (2) <u>Devils who form deceptions</u> Today, those fallen angels are called devils and have continued to cause darkness and deceptions on people all over the world. They work to lead man away from God's ways and instead to commit deeds which bring hurts and grieve the Lord God. Example: addictions, superstitions, unbelief, gambling and other bondages. (Rev 12:9)
- (3) <u>The roaring lion</u> According to the Bible: "Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour." *The spiritual wickedness will use different means and ways to cause man to sin, to be deceived and to become bound.* (1 Peter 5:8, 9)
- (4) <u>Jesus' victory on the cross</u> Jesus' death on the cross has crushed the devils' powers. The Lord has won the victory and given his authority to all who believe in Him. As for those who submit to God's words, the demons no longer have real authority. They are like lions without teeth. These enemies can only threaten or tempt but cannot do anything to God's people who resist them. (Psalm 60:12)
- (5) <u>Our Victory through Christ Jesus</u> The Lord Jesus is Jehovah Nissi our Banner of victory. When we depend on Jesus, we will be able to overcome all temptations of sin and evil. (Luke 10:19)

**Conclusion**: We must depend on the Lord Jesus to become victorious Christians who overcome temptations, and please the Lord God.
