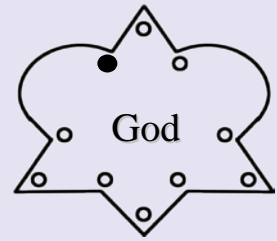


# Truly Great To Know God

## 1.9 Jehovah Rohi

**Bible Verse:** Psalm 16:11 You will show me the path of life.  
In your presence there is fullness of joy.



**Proclaim:** *The Lord will show me the path of life.*

**Truth:** Jesus said, “I am the Way, the Truth and the Life.” He is our good Shepherd; we are His sheep and we must obey His Word.



**Scripture Reference: John 10: 1-16**

- Lesson:**
- (1) **We are the Lord’s sheep** – The psalmist wrote regarding our relationship to the Lord: “We are the people of his pasture and the sheep of His hand” (Psalm 95:7).
  - (2) **Sheep needs protection** – *The characteristic of sheep is such that they need the guidance of a shepherd so that they will not get lost. Furthermore, they need protection by the shepherd so as not to fall prey to the ravaging wolves. In the same way, as God’s people, we must be on guard against the “ravaging wolves” in our daily life. Such would appear to include the negative influences such as from those television programs that entrap young people today, leading many to failure and the wasting of their time.*
  - (3) **Jesus is the good Shepherd** – Read the scriptures from Psalm 23 – “The LORD is my shepherd... He leads me beside quiet waters...”  
*The Lord Jesus wants to lead us to make right decisions in our daily life. For only the Lord knows what is best for us.*
  - (4) **Obedience to God’s Word** – *The Bible teaches us that the sheep must listen to the Great Shepherd’s voice.*  
“My sheep listens to my voice. I know them and they follow me.”  
*(Hold up the Bible – explain how this is the voice of God).* (John 10:27)
  - (5) **Not listening to the enemy** – *All sheep must differentiate between the Shepherd’s voice and the enemies’ voices which come to deceive and to lead people astray. In everyday living, one must be careful with what is conveyed in the magazines and books, that we come across, that contradict the precepts of God.* (John 10:4-5)

**Conclusion:** Jesus is the Way, the Truth and the Life. He has made known to us the path of life and He will fill us with joy in His presence. We need to follow closely after God, and learn to know His voice.

<b>BIBLE STORY NARRATION</b>	<b>Genesis 28:10-17 God was present with Jacob</b>
<b>OBJECT LESSON</b>	Jesus’ words, as found in the Bible, is the map for our life (John 10: 4- The sheep obeys its shepherd’s voice)
<b>SHOW &amp; TELL</b>	Show the globe or map to the students. Name a few countries/places for students to locate these. 1. The sheep represent those who are lost or in need of real meaning for life. 2. They urgently need to know the LORD Jesus who wants to save and guide their lives.
<b>PRAY</b>	Pray to know God’s guidance to live by His voice and have victory over bad influences of the digital medias. (Other Prayers: _____)
