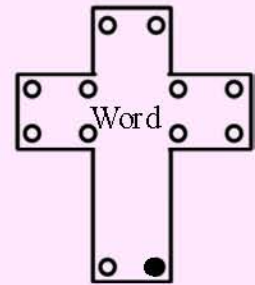


# WORD of TRULY GREAT FREEDOM

## 2.6 This Victory

**Bible Verse :** 1 John 4:4  
 You are from God and have overcome them  
 because the One who is in you is greater than  
 the one who is in the world.



**Proclaim :** *He that is in me is greater than he that is in the world.*

**Truth:** Through the blood of God's Lamb and the testimonies of His word,  
 we can be more than conquerors.

**Scripture Reference: Matthew 4:1-11**

"Then Jesus was led by the Spirit into the desert... After fasting for 40 days  
 and 40 nights, He was hungry.

The tempter came to Him and said, 'If you are the Son of God, tell these stones to become bread.' "



- Lesson:**
- (1) When the devil said to Jesus, "...tell these stones to become bread",  
 how did the Lord reply?  
 (Man cannot live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God)
  - (2) When the devil said to Jesus, "all the kingdoms of the world and their  
 splendor I will give you if you will bow down and worship me",  
 how did the Lord overcome this temptation?  
 (Jesus said to him, "Away from me, Satan! For it is written: Worship the Lord your  
 God, and serve him only. ")
  - (3) Many people think that God does not want man to have too much fun and  
 pleasure. Do you agree?  
 (This is a lie for the Lord God wants all man to have joy in Him.)
  - (4) How did Jesus overcome all of the devil's temptations?  
 (By using God Word)
  - (5) Do you think that today, the devil still uses different lies and temptations to  
 steal the hearts of man?
  - (6) What does Psalm 119:9 teach us about how a young person can keep his  
 way pure? (By living according to God's word.)

**Conclusion:** The Lord Jesus is the risen Savior. He is calling us to overcome the  
 temptations and deception of the devil like He did. The bible tells us: "Life  
 and death lie beneath the tongue". Thus, we must reject the words of the  
 devil and speak the words of God.

<b>BIBLE NARRATION</b>	<b>Matthew 4: 1-11 Jesus was tempted in the wilderness</b>
<b>QUESTION &amp; ANSWER</b>	(refer to Questions in Course book Lesson 2:6)
<b>TELL</b>	The Lord in great love had fasted for many days while in the wilderness. He had total victory over Satan's attacks by speaking God's words. Today, Jesus is calling us to overcome deceptions and temptations from the devils like He did.
<b>PRAY</b>	Ask God for help to remember and obey all of His words/instructions for life (Other Prayers: _____)
