Truly Great Will of God

3.8 Proclaim LORD Jesus

Bible Verse: Matthew 24:14

And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all nations and then the end shall come.

Proclaim: I want to proclaim the name of Jesus so that many might

believe and be saved.

Truth: God has sent His son into the world to save all people. Those who believe in Him

are not condemned but those who disbelieve stand condemned already. Thus we must proclaim the Lord Jesus, calling many to believe the Lord and be saved.

Scripture Reference: Matthew 28:16-20

Lesson: (1) Lord Jesus' final words — Consider: what were Jesus' last words to His disciples before He left the earth? According to Matthew 28:18-20, Jesus said: 'All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore, go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you'. The one who is dying will not say trivial things! Thus we understand that to preach the gospel to all the nations is the most important task given by God. The gospel/good news is — "He who calls on the Lord's name shall be saved." Anyone who confess Christ Jesus as Lord, and believe with the heart that God has raised Him from the dead, will be saved. (Acts 2:21; Romans 10:9)

- (2) <u>Spread the gospel everywhere</u> According to Matt 24:14: "this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all nations and then the end shall come." *Jesus had compassion on the crowds because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd. Jesus went through all the towns and villages, teaching ... and turning men's hearts to repentance unto God.* (Luke 9:35-36)
- (3) <u>Lead people to know the Savior</u> "God so love the world that He gave His only begotten Son so that all who believe in Him might not perish but have everlasting life", "Whoever believes in Him is not condemned, but those who disbelieve in Him stand condemned already." *Thus all people need to know the Lord. The work of fishermen is to bring many fishes to the shore. Likewise, the work of God's people is to help people come back to God.* (John 3:16, 18)
- (4) The Message of the cross The Bible teaches that the Good News about Jesus' death on the cross and His resurrection has the divine power for all mankind's salvation. That is why we must share the message of the cross with our family, friends and as many others as we can. (1 Corinthians 1:18)

<u>Conclusion:</u> The Bible tells us that all people need to know the Lord's salvation. The gospel must be spread everywhere, only then can the end come. Thus, let us proclaim the Lord's Name and share the gospel with many.

OBJECT LESSON	A Dying man with trivial final words

Jesus said: "Go to all the world and make disciples of all men, baptizing themand teaching them all that I had commanded" 3. Thus we know how important Jesus' final instructions were. (Matthew 28:18-20)
