Lesson:(1) <u>God created all by His mighty words</u> – The Bible states that in the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth. The earth was formless and empty.

(2) God made man in His own image – The Bible recorded that the heavens and the earth belong to God. "The heavens are yours, and yours also the earth; you founded the world and all that is in it."

The Lord God created many things. Countless things have been created by Him: the marvelous giraffe and the lovable elephant, etc. But of all creation, God esteems man as the most special, because God had created man and woman in His own image. (Psalm 89:11; Genesis 1:26,27)

- (3) God's great love for man and woman The Bible states also that God loves mankind very much. God's love is patient and kind. "It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres." Therefore, we understand that God loves us all and that He always believes, always hopes and always perseveres in His great love for us. (I Corinthians 13:4,7)
- (4) Man ought to worship and serve God "Worship the Lord with gladness; come before Him with joyful songs. Know that the Lord is God. It is He who made us, and we are His.." We should therefore serve the Lord our God gladly because He is our Father in heaven, who is worthy of our eternal worship and honor. (Psalm 100:1-3)

Conclusion: God created us because of His great love for us.

Thus our lives belong to Him and we must live according to His purposes.
