1.7 Almighty God

Bible Verse: Matthew 8:27

The men were amazed and asked: "What kind of man is this?

Even the winds and the waves obey Him!"

Proclaim: With men, this is impossible. But with God, all things

are possible.

Truth: The Lord is great and worthy of exuberant praise. His greatness is

immeasurable. This generation will praise God for His mighty deeds

and will declare His greatness to the next generation.

Scripture Reference: Matthew 8:23-27

Lesson: (1) God's almighty deeds — When the Son of God Jesus Christ was on earth, He used 5 loaves and 2 fishes to feed 5000 men. "And taking the five loaves and the two fish, he looked up to heaven, and blessed and broke them, and gave them to the disciples to set before the crowd. And all ate and were filled. What was left over was gathered up, twelve baskets of broken pieces. "Jesus also healed the sick people who had incurable diseases and gave sight to the blind. Even the winds and the sea obeyed Him. (Luke 9:12-15)

- (2) God's almighty commands God drove the waters of the Red Sea back with a strong east wind, enabling His chosen People, the Israelites, to cross the Sea. "The waters were divided and the Israelites went through the sea on dry ground.." Theologians cannot determine the depth of the Red sea at that time. The entire Red Sea was 558 m deep on average and deepest at 2514 m. However, it was too deep for anyone to go across and besides, it was so deep that its waters submerged the entire army chariots and horsemen of Pharoah. (Exodus 14:21-30)
- (3) Nothing is impossible with God Our God, Jehovah, is almighty. It is written in the bible: "The heavens are Yours, and Yours also the earth; You founded the world and all that is in it." He created the heaven and the earth! There is nothing impossible with God. (Psalm 89:11)
- (3) God who is faithful and worthy of trust The Bible commands us to always keep our trust in God for the man who depend on God will be blessed. "O Lord Almighty, blessed is the man who trusts in you." (Psalm 84:1)

Conclusion: Our resurrected Lord Jesus, the almighty God, is totally able and willing to help us. Thus, we can pray to our God and can depend on Him at all times.
