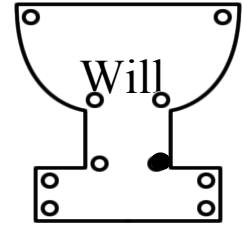


Truly Great Will of God

3.3 Complete Faith

Bible Verse: Hebrews 11:30

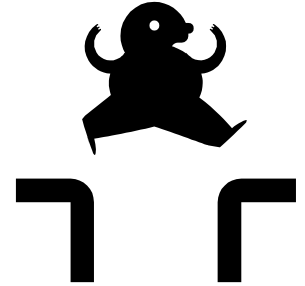
By faith the walls of Jericho fell down,
after the people had marched around them for seven days.



Proclaim: *I believe in God's Word more than what I can see.*

Truth: Great is the Lord and mighty in power. His wisdom cannot be fathomed. Those who depend on Him are like Mount Zion for they shall never be moved or shaken.

Definition of Faith: Although we have not seen God, we believe that He exists and that he rewards those who seek Him. We can trust Him because He is great and mighty in power and His understanding has no limit. (Hebrews 11:6; Psalm 147:5)



Scripture Reference: Joshua 6:1-20

Introduction: The Israelites, because of their supernatural faith in God when they confronted the city of Jericho, received God's help and were victorious. It was a true story.

- (1) Problems faced by the Israelites.
(Jericho's wall was closed tightly and no one could enter)
- (2) What they do in seven days. *(March around Jericho wall once every day)*
- (3) The reactions of the people in Jericho.
(they probably thought the Israelites could never succeed)
- (4) What caused the Jericho wall to collapse?
(the priests blew their trumpets and the Israelites gave a loud shout)
- (5) What weapons the Israelites used?
- (6) Did Joshua depend on his own thinking or on God's ways? *(God's method)*
- (7) Will you depend on God's promises or on what you see?

Conclusion: According to Hebrews 11:7 – we exercise faith when we depend on God's promises and guidance for things which are not yet seen. Let us be like Joshua of old – not to depend on our natural sight alone but to live according to God's words and His promises.

Prayer/Invitation: Pray that today's truths will be written on our hearts in Lord Jesus' name.
