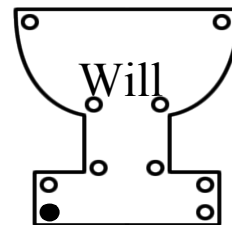


Truly Great Will of God

3.6 Build God's Kingdom

Bible Verse: Matthew 6:33

Seek ye first the kingdom of God and His righteousness...
and all these things shall be added unto you.



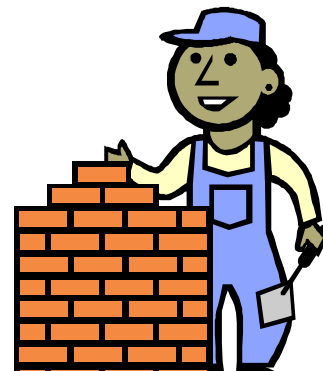
Proclaim: *I want to build God's kingdom, and let Jesus be king*

Truth: God's salvation for man delivers him from the power of darkness and bring him into His eternally glorious Kingdom.

Scripture Reference: Matthew 6: 25-34

Lesson: (1) **God's will for our lives** – *It is God's will that everyone can*

enter His glorious kingdom. Thus He wants us to build His kingdom on earth. Luke 17:21 clearly states that the coming of God's kingdom is not visible to the eyes because God's kingdom is in the hearts of His people. When people decide to accept their Savior Jesus, they become people of God's kingdom, called out of darkness into God's eternal kingdom, and from a sinful life to a new life. (Colossians 1:13-14)



(2) **To build and not destroy** – *What we say is crucial. Our words can edify and help people to know God or hurt and stumble them, hindering their belief in God. Words have the power to edify but also the power to destroy. For instance, habitual gossiping often results in hurting others. God is a God of love and compassion, and wants us to build live. When the Lord Jesus was on earth, He walked throughout the different towns and villages to help the sad and hopeless. He even touched the lepers with his hands and healed them. (1John 4:8; Mark 1:40-41)*

(3) **To build Heavenly Kingdom** – *The bible recorded that John the Baptist had loudly proclaimed the coming of the Lord Jesus: "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is near!" And Jesus continually taught about the kingdom of heaven as He knew that leading others to God's kingdom is the will of the Heavenly Father. (Matthew 3:1-3; 9:35-36)*

(4) **To have great peace and blessings** – *The Bible states: "Seek first God's kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well". We must love the will of God wholeheartedly, and love souls more than the things of the world. For the bible states that those who do the will of God shall be greatly blessed, and God will supply all their needs. Those who seek earnestly to do God's will shall assuredly receive divine leading and great peace. (Psalm 16:11; 37:4)*

Conclusion: The Lord God does not want us to be troubled about the future, but to build His Kingdom with our whole hearts and to help others know Jesus as the King.

Prayer/Invitation: Pray that today's truths will be written on our hearts in Lord Jesus' name.
