Bible Verse: John 14:3 And if I go and prepare a place for you,


I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am.

Proclaim: God has a crown for the one who longs for the Lord's appearing.

Truth: Those who endure temptations and are prepared for the Lord's coming return are blessed indeed. They shall obtain the crown of life that God has promised to

those who love Him.

Scripture Reference: Matthew 25: 1-13; Rev 22:6-21



- (2) To be set apart for holiness In the story of the ten virgins, wise were those who had sufficient oil in their lamps. They had made preparations according to the Bride groom's wishes. When he was delayed in coming, they took the initiative to prepare more oil. On the other hand, the other five virgins were foolish. They did not pay heed to their master, but instead did as they pleased. As a result, the bridegroom rejected them, saying: "Assuredly, I say to you, I do not know you." For the Lord God has said: to be carnally-minded is death, but to be spiritually minded is life and peace. We must be like the wise virgins, who set themselves apart for holiness and were ready for the bridegroom's coming again. (Matthew 25:11-13)
- (3) To be kind to one another The Lord Jesus is coming back to receive His church. It will be a holy, radiant church with love and unity. Therefore, the Lord requires us to be humble and gentle towards one another, having kindness and forgiveness toward each other. God is love. When we encourage and affirm one another, building others up, we shall be living according to God's Spirit indeed. (Ephesians 4:2, 32; 1 John 4:16)
- (4) To be good witnesses for the Lord At His appearing, "the Lord himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord. " What a glorious but fearsome Day! According to the bible: All knees shall bow, and all mouths shall confess the Lord. Each one shall have to give an account of himself before God. Hence, we must be good witnesses of the Lord so that others may know the truth and can also be prepared. (1 Thessalonians 4:16-17; John 8:32; Romans 14:11-12)

The Bible recorded that Christ Jesus ascended to heaven from Jerusalem after His resurrection. On the day of His return, the Lord will descend to this world in the same way. (Acts 1:9-11).
