

1.6 Holy Triune God

Bible Verse: Therefore, go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. – Matthew 28:19

Proclaim: *God the Father has, by His Son, sent His Spirit upon us.*

Main Lesson Points:

Truth:

- God is a Triune God: the Father, Son & the Holy Spirit.
- God the Father sent His Son, Jesus Christ, to save us.
- His Holy Spirit to comfort and help us.

Three, but One

The concept of a Triune God can be difficult for our minds to understand. An easier way to understand this concept is to think of water. Water can be present in three different forms—liquid (water), gas (steam), solid (ice)—but all three are the same matter in essence. By analogy, God the Father, Jesus Christ the Son and the Holy Spirit are all One and the same God, yet existing in three Persons of equal status and position.
