Separation That's a Blessing:

It's odd to think of ourselves as aliens in this world, but that's exactly what we should be. We are called to not be of the value of this world, but to be of God. Consider the seating of a flight passenger: if he chooses an economy seat, he cannot have the first-class seat. Similarly, man cannot love the things of the world and love God at the same time. The worldly things distance man from the love of God. Thus we must choose to be separate from the things of the world and be set apart for God.
