## 2.2 This Salvation

Bible Verse: The Virgin will be with child and will give birth to a son, and they will call Him Emmanuel. - Matthew 1:23

Proclaim: By faith in Lord Jesus, I am now saved.

**Truth:** God's Son, Jesus Christ, forsook his glorious most high position and came to the earth. He died on the cross for mankind and resurrected on the third day, so that all who believe in Him may receive pardon from their sins and salvation from God the Father.

A Solution to a Dirty Problem:
