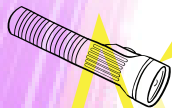


## 2.4 This Light

**Bible Verse:** If we confess our sins, He who is faithful and just will forgive us our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness. – 1 John 1:9

### Truth:

Jesus said, "I am the light of the world. He who follows me will no longer walk in the darkness, but will have the light of life."



**Proclaim:** *If I confess my sins to God, I will have His cleansing and His light*
