

2.5 This New Life

Bible Verse: Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; everything old has passed away; see, everything has become new! – 2 Corinthians 5:17

Proclaim: *In Christ Jesus, I am a new creation.*

Scripture:
Luke 19:1-8

Truth: Those who believe in the Lord Jesus have already been freed from darkness and have entered into the light. They are no longer to live for themselves but for the Lord who died and rose again.
