## 2.9 This Healing



Bible Verse: But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon him, and by his wounds we are healed. - Isaiah 53:5

Proclaim: By his stripes, Lord Jesus has brought my healing and peace.

Truth: Jesus Christ is the God who heals us. The punishment which He bore on the cross has brought us peace and by His wounds He has brought us healing.

Broken, But Healed:
