3.5 Complete Strength

Bible Verse:

I can do everything through Him who gives me strength. - Philippians 4:13

Proclaim: By the power of the Holy Spirit, I can do all things.

Truth: Be strong and courageous and do not be afraid.

Those who depend fully on the Holy Spirit shall be able to do all things.

Strength When Broken:

For I have the desire to do what is good, but cannot carry it out. For what I do is not the good I want to do...the evil I do not want to do, this I keep on doing." However, Paul experienced an ever ready strength that he could call on. God has given us the power of the Holy Spirit to give us strength, but we must ask for it. God can give us divine strength in place of our weaknesses.
