3.6 Build God's Kingdom

Bible Verse:

Seek ye first the kingdom of God and His righteousness...and all these things shall be added unto you. - Matthew 6:33

Truth:

God's salvation for man delivers him from the power of darkness and brings him into His eternally glorious Kingdom.

- To build Heavenly Kingdom Mat 3:1-3, 9:35-36

A Love that Multiplies:
