

3.8 Proclaim Lord Jesus

Bible Verse: And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in the whole World as testimony to all nations and then the end shall come. – **Matthew 24:14**

Proclaim: *I want to proclaim the name of Jesus so that many might believe and be saved.*

Truth: God has sent His Son into the world to save all people. Those who believe in Him are not condemned but those who disbelieve stand condemned already. Thus we must proclaim the Lord Jesus, calling many to believe the Lord and be saved.

Main Lesson Points:

- **Lord Jesus' final words** – Mat 28:18-20, Act 2:21
- **Spread the gospel everywhere** – Luk 9:35-36
- **Lead people to know the Savior** – Joh 3:16, 18
- **The Message of the cross** – 1 Cor 1:18
