

4.6 Live by God's Word

Bible Verse: But the one who hears my words and does not put them into practice is like a man who built a house on the ground without a foundation. The moment the torrent struck that house, it collapsed and its destruction was complete. – Luke 6:49

Proclaim: *Let us hear and obey God's Word and thus be beloved of God.*

Truth: Lord Jesus said: "He who has my commands and obeys them is the one who loves Me. He who loves me shall be loved of My Father, and I too shall love him and reveal myself to him."
