4.7 Glorify God in Everything

Bible Verse: so whether you eat or drink or whatever you do; do it all for the glory of God. - 1 Corinthians 10:31

Proclaim: Let us exalt the Lord so that His glory may fill the whole world.

Truth: Lord Jesus has become the Prince of Peace for all men by His death on the cross. It is God's will for us to glorify the Lord in everything, so that others may see His salvation and His glory.
