do it all for the glory of God.


Proclaim: Let us exalt the Lord so that His glory may fill the whole world.

Truth: Lord Jesus has become the Prince of Peace for all men by His death on the cross. It is God's will for us to glorify the Lord in everything,

so that others may see His salvation and His glory.

Scripture Reference: Matthew 21:1-9

Lesson:(1) Let all man see God's glory — Matthew 21 recorded that when Jesus entered Jerusalem before He departed from the earth, His disciples did as Jesus had instructed them. They brought a donkey and colt with their garments laid on them for Jesus to sit on. A very large crowd spread their cloaks on the road, while



- (2) Glorify Jesus to turn hearts to God Lord Jesus, the most high and holy One said: "And I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all men to myself"!

 The message of Jesus' death on the cross in His great love is powerful!

 Therefore, when we glorify the Lord, hearts will be turned and reconciled to God.

 (John 12:32, 1 Corinthians 1:18)
- (3) God can greatly use young people Do not despise those who are young. God's will is to use the youths and children. Imagine: The moon itself has no light but uses light from the sun to bring light to the night. God used five loaves and two fish from a child to meet the needs of over 5,000 people. He also anointed young children to declare: "Hosanna to the Son of David!" (John 6:1-13, Matthew 21:15)
- (4) Glorify God in everything The Bible teaches that we are not our own; we were bought at a price. Therefore, we are to honor God with our body. "So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God." The Holy Spirit is helping us to glorify God by our good speech and conduct, so that others can also know the Lord who had come to the world from heaven. (1 Corinthian 6:20)

Conclusion:

The Lord God said: "From the rising of the sun to the place of its setting, My name shall be exalted." So let us magnify the Lord always and show forth His salvation and His presence.
