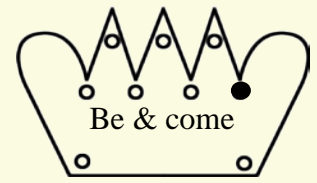


# Truly Great When Christ Comes Again



## 5.3 Glorious Worship

**Bible Verse:** Psalm 22:3

Yet you are enthroned as the Holy One; you are the praise of Israel.

**Proclaim:** *We will worship God and come to His glorious presence.*

**Truth:** Oh Lord God, I will honor and praise your Name forever, so that the world may know your mighty deeds and the glory of your Kingdom.



**Scripture Reference: Psalms 103**

**Lesson: (1) God is worthy of praise and worship** – *The book of Psalms reveals how our God is worthy of all honor, praise and worship. Let us exalt and praise God every day for He is great. “Great is the Lord and worthy of all praises”; “The Lord is righteous in all His ways and is loving toward all He has made”; “For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is His love for those who fear Him”. (Psalm 145:1-3)*

**(2) We are created to worship God** – *GOD had created us all to worship Him and give thanks to Him in all things. David, a great man of the Bible had written: “Praise the Lord, O my soul... and forget not all his benefits”. God has forgiven all our sins, healed us of our diseases, redeemed us from the power of death, and granted us strength and satisfaction. (Psalm 103:1-5)*

**(3) Name that is above all names** – *Lord Jesus Christ! What a glorious and precious name - the name that is above all names! The bible declares: “Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.” For He has shed His blood for us and bore all our sins on the cross. Therefore, let us praise His Holy name every day, and let His name be lifted up in all the earth, today and forevermore. (Acts 2:21; Psalm 72:18-19)*

**(4) Come abide in God’s glorious presence** – *Man is comprised of three parts: spirit, soul and body. The body, which the Bible refers to as the “flesh”, is carnal in nature and naturally does not like to worship God. Therefore, let us be determined to worship God with our hearts. Let us come into His glorious and joyful presence for God wants to give strength to those who are weary, comfort those who have sorrows, and give new hope to the hopeless. (Romans 7:18-19, 1 Chronicles 16:26-27)*

**Conclusion:** God is enthroned on our praises and worship. So may we worship Him with much singing and dwell in His glorious presence, giving glory to our most high Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.
